

CFFA PHOTO CONTEST

We announced the contest in the May newsletter, and this month we are going to repeat the requirements and tell you how to submit your entries. We will accept entries in three categories (1) 8 by 10 black and white prints; (2) 35 mm color slides and (3) regular size prints from Instamatic, Polaroid or similar cameras. Only CFFA members may participate, and only 2 entries may be submitted in each category. All photos must have been taken between the May Annual Outing and October 1, 1981, and must show some aspect of fly fishing.

All entries will be displayed at a monthly meeting or the Annual Banquet, and suitable prizes will be given to the finalists in each category. All entries will remain unidentified throughout the judging process, and the final selections will be made by a panel of persons with fishing and photographic expertise.

Entries should be submitted to either Larry Johnson or Ed Fidrych by mail or at a regular meeting. We must have them on or before the November meeting, which will be held on November 18 due to a conflict with Veteran's Day. Place your entries in a sturdy manila envelope, and protect them with one or more pieces of cardboard. It probably wouldn't hurt to mark the envelope "Photographs-Do Not Bend". Enclose any information you wish about the photo, such as title, time and place it was taken, camera, lens, setting, film used etc. along with your name, address and telephone number. All entries will be returned.
